

2024-2029 Community Development Block Grant Consolidated Plan

JEFFERSON CITY, MO. (March 9, 2023)- The City of Jefferson would like to invite members of the public to participate in determining how Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds are invested in the community.

The City of Jefferson must prepare a Consolidated Plan every five years that outlines the City's plans for the use of U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) grants in infrastructure, housing, public services, and economic development. Projects must typically benefit low to moderate income persons.

The City developed a survey that will help identify funding priorities for the Community Development Block Grant Program from 2024 to 2029. The City anticipates to receive approximately \$300,000 each year. The survey closed on January 27, 2023. 91 responses were received. The survey results may be viewed at the following [link](#).
