## Annual Listing of Obligated Projects for Fiscal Year 2015

September 4, 2015

This *Annual Listing of Obligated Projects* report is the listing of the amount of funds for projects in the CAMPO planning area that have been obligated during CAMPO Fiscal year from **July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015**.

The Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP 21) legislation outlines the requirement for Metropolitan Planning Organizations to publish an annual listing of projects for which funds have been obligated in the preceding year including a listing of pedestrian and bicycle projects. 23 U.S.C. 135(g)(4)(B), 49 U.S.C. 5303(j)(7)(B), and 49 U.S.C. 5304(g)(4)(B) and Section 20005(j)(7)(B) of MAP 21 states:

"...an Annual Listing of projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year shall be published or otherwise made available by the cooperative effort of the State, transit operator, and metropolitan planning organization for public review. The listing shall be consistent with the funding categories identified in each metropolitan transportation improvement program (TIP)."

For FTA projects, obligation occurs when the FTA grant is awarded. For FHWA projects obligation occurs when a project agreement is executed and the State/grantee requests that the funds be obligated.

Within this context, an obligation is the Federal government's legal commitment to pay the Federal share of a project's cost. An obligated project is one that has been authorized by the Federal agency and funds have been obligated. Projects for which funds have been obligated are not necessarily initiated or completed in the program year, and the amount of the obligation will not necessarily equal the total cost of the project.

Designated recipients shall continue to sub-allocate funds allocated to an urbanized area based on a locally determined process, consistent with Section 5307 statutory requirements. Each State's share of a multi-state urbanized area was calculated on the basis of the percentage of population attributable to the States in the UZA, as determined by the 2010 Census.
