- Must be at least 18 years of age
- No felony convictions

- Must be willing and able to work rotating shifts
- Must be able to pass all requirements of the selection process

APPLICATION AND HIRING PROCESS:

Stage 1 TESTING

- · Testing is generally conducted twice per year
- · Application must be received by cutoff date
