

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Thank you for enrolling your child(ren) in the Youth Summer Volleyball Program with the Jefferson City Parks and Recreation Department. We hope you and your child(ren) have a great and fun season!

I wanted to give you some information regarding the league.


IMPORTANT INFORMATION!

- **Program T-Shirts** – each player will receive a program t-shirt based on the size you gave us when you registered. Coaches will hand them out when they are available based on the size you ordered. I do not have extra shirts so hopefully your child's shirt fits them.
- **Seating/Spectators** – you will need to bring your own seating at Binder (sand volleyball).
- **Reminder: NO pets, tobacco products, alcoholic beverages or glass containers** allowed at any facility during youth sports – this is a health and safety issue!
- **Practices** – coaches set up and secure the practices.
- We recommend that your child(ren) wear knee pads (indoor leagues) but it is not required.
- **Coaching** - your coach should have had a parent meeting with you to communicate their coaching style, league rules, etc. If they were not able to have a meeting and you would like to know this information, please make sure you call or talk to them after your practice.
 - And thank you so much to all of you that have volunteered your time to coach a youth volleyball team.
 - Coach Evaluation – all of the coaches in our youth volleyball league are either certified through the National Alliance for Youth Sports or by IMPACT. If you would like to have an evaluation form for your coach, please let me know and I will send you one. Through the NYSCA, I can set up a survey on-line specific to each coach but I cannot do this through Impact, I can send you a form by email.

- **Officials** – please be respectful of the officials. These are recreational leagues and not all leagues will have experienced officials. Some of them are learning just as your child is. They have all been given the same set of rules as you have and the coach has. They have all received training but as you know, no one person is perfect and everyone’s judgment is different. If you have a major concern with your official, please talk to your coach about it and then they can relay the information to me if needed. We want to have quality officials that care about the program and that know our league rules.
- **Schedules are posted on-line** at www.teamsideline.com/jeffersoncity. Just click on the + signs next to Youth Volleyball, grade, team name, etc. You can print the schedule for just your team or for all the teams in your league. You can also download your child’s volleyball schedule to your calendar if you use Outlook.
- **Gymnasium Locations** – on the schedule on-line, if you click on the green arrow next to the facility name, it will bring up a map for you if you are not familiar with the gym you play at. Most gyms have their own entrance.

- All players in the 3rd – 6th grade indoor leagues will receive a “gift (will email out a vote on this)” near the end of the season.
