League/Night (all leagues are 4 v 4)

Boys' League – Friday evenings – four weeks (double-headers)

Girls' League – Friday evenings – four weeks (double-headers)

Co-Ed League – Friday evenings – four weeks (double-headers)

(All players must currently be enrolled in high school)

Registration Information

1. Registrations will be accepted Monday, February 29 through 5 p.m. Monday, March 21. Play will begin Friday, April 1.
2. A team roster must consist of at least 5 and no more than 8 players. The last day to make roster changes is Friday, April 8.
3. Participants register as teams. Individuals wanting to play will be given access to team manager and roster lists in an attempt to find a team on which to play. A list of players wanting to play will also be kept at the Parks and Recreation Department for managers looking for players.
4. To register, simply complete the roster form and return it to the Parks and Recreation office along with your team fee and forfeit fee deposit. Or register on-line at:

5. If you register on-line, your roster and forfeit fee must be brought to the Parks and Recreation office by March 21.
6. A minimum of four teams will be needed for any league and a maximum of eight teams will be accepted in any league.
7. Registration fee is:

Team Fee: \$150 **Team Fee After March 21:** \$170 ***Forfeit Fee Deposit:** \$37.50
(if space is available)

This fee must be paid at the time of registration with a check or credit card **SEPARATE from the team entry fee. The check will not be cashed nor the credit card charged unless a team forfeits a game(s).*

The Playing Field

Games will be played on Lions Field or Eagles Whitener Field in Washington Park.

Regulation Game

Games will consist of four, 5-minute periods. Games tied at the end of the time limit will remain a tie.

Number of Players (on the field)

1. Each team will play with 4 players on the field
2. A minimum of three players will be required for a game to start or continue.

Uniforms/Equipment

1. All players on a team must wear the same color shirt.
2. Players must wear tennis shoes or rubber cleats. No sandals, flip flops, open-toed shoes, or barefoot allowed.
3. Players must remove all jewelry.
4. All equipment will be provided

General Rules

1. Kick Off – The ball is placed in the center of the field and teams line up on their respective goal lines. When the whistle blows, both teams rush to the ball for possession. This will happen each time a goal is scored.
2. There is no designated goalie. No defensive player allowed in the goal circle/box unless the offense has the ball in the goal circle/box.

3. When the ball goes out of bounds it is entered back into play by the team last in possession before it went out of bounds.
4. Balls in Bubble – Should a ball get stuck in a bubble with a player, play will be paused while the ball is recovered and the referee will perform a drop ball at the spot of the occurrence with one player from each team.
5. Substitutions - Substitutions can only be made between periods.

Player Conduct/Disciplinary Action

1. This is a social recreational game! Players are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner and display good sportsmanship.
2. Overly rough play, abusive or profane language, or unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Depending on the severity of the action, a warning may be given by the referee for a first offense, but a warning is not guaranteed. A second offense or a flagrant first offense will result in the offending player being ejected for the remainder of the game. This will be the referee's judgment and his/her decision is final.
3. The referee has the authority to remove anyone from any game, for any reason to gain effective control of the game, including but not limited to, player misconduct, player safety concerns, or use of profanity.

Schedules

1. Each team will be scheduled for eight games.
2. Games will be scheduled 30 minutes apart.
3. Players need to arrive **at least** ten minutes prior to game time.
4. Schedules and all make-up games will be posted on-line only. 5. Once registration has ended, we will discuss with the teams the possibility of having a tournament or play-off at the end of the season. There could be an additional charge, if it is decided to have a tournament.

League Champion

Standings will be kept and individual awards will be given to the league championship team. If no tournament or play-off is scheduled, and teams are tied at the end of the season, head-to-head competition will be used to determine the league champion. If that does not determine the champion, a play-off game(s) will be scheduled to determine the champion.
