

WELCOME TO BINDER ADVENTURE DAY CAMP!

We are very happy that you have enrolled your child in our summer day camp program. Along with all of the activities that we had last year, we will be trying out some new ideas and programs. We would like to hear from you and your child. We will be emailing you a link for an on-line survey at the conclusion of camp.

We require a parent, guardian, or other designated individual to personally check each camper into and out of our day camp with a staff member each day. Please do not drop off your child in the morning or have your child meet you outside the camp or pool. We will not allow your child to leave without someone getting him or her.

This year, Binder Adventure Camp and Camp Eagle will be held at separate locations. Binder Camp will meet at the Binder Pavilion on the southeast side of Binder Lake. Campers may be dropped off at camp or may take the bus to camp. This year's bus route is new and we hope it will serve you better. We assign a camp counselor to ride the camp bus both to the camp in the morning and back in the afternoon.

Please know that our camps are drug, alcohol and tobacco free zones. City policy prohibits us from holding or dispensing any prescription or over-the-counter medication either internally or externally. Our first aid policy only allows us to insure breathing, control bleeding and swelling. We cannot administer any medicine, either internal or external, under any circumstances. This includes salves, topical ointments, sting-ease, pain reliever, anti-ivy. We are permitted to assist your child in applying sun screen or insect repellent that he or she brings. In the unlikely event that your child is injured, we will contact you immediately with the details and asking for your guidance on further care, if needed.

What to wear/bring:

1. Have your child eat a nutritious and filling breakfast. We plan on lots of hard play!
2. Campers should wear play clothes and tennis shoes and bring a swim suit.
3. Campers should bring their own lunch every day. We suggest that lunches be brought in coolers since we are unable to provide refrigeration. Please include a water bottle for your child, we will have jugs from which to fill them once empty. Please do not bring glass containers of any kind to camp.
4. Campers should bring and wear sunscreen and insect repellent.
5. Lunches, jackets, sunscreen, etc. should be marked with camper's name.
6. To maintain our proper counselor/camper ratio, campers should not bring a friend to camp who is not enrolled in our program.
7. Since we cannot be held responsible for lost valuables, we suggest that campers should not bring any electronics, phones, jewelry, watches, pocket knives or other valuables to camp.

Times are approximate and can change due to traffic. Please be sure to arrive five minutes prior to the scheduled pick up time in the morning.

- ** When the After Camp Swim is on, we will reduce the route to two stops: Memorial Pool and Washington Park. You can choose to have your non-swimming child dropped off at either the Memorial Pool or the Washington Park stop. If you wish to have your child supervised until 4:00 p.m. until you pick him or her up, you may have your child use the Memorial Pool stop. We will supervise him or her at the pool until you arrive. You will need to come into the Pool to check out your child.
- *** If After Camp Swim is canceled, we will revert to the full bus schedule. We will drop your child off at the location you used to dropped off your child.

AFTER CAMP SWIM PROGRAM INFORMATION

We offer a bus stop in Memorial Park. Children that are signed up for the After Camp Swim program will get off the bus at this stop. Swimmers will be supervised by camp staff once they get off the bus. Children in the After Camp Swim program must be picked up at Memorial Pool no later than 5:15 p.m.

AFTER CAMP SWIM PROGRAM CANCELLATION

Unfortunately, we do not have the ability to keep children past 3:00 p.m. at Binder Pavilion if the After Camp Swim Program is canceled. In the event that After Camp Swim is canceled, We will have your child get off at the bus stop that you used to dropped off your child. Please pick up your child at that stop, please arrive before the designated time. We will be unable to hold the bus at any stop, as this will put us behind schedule. To avoid confusion, we ask that you do not change stops for pickup or drop off. We will attempt to contact you to

let you know of the cancellation at the numbers you give us. We will also give you a "rain check" swim pass that your child can use to go swimming at one of our pools at a time of your choosing free of charge.
