April is Fair Housing Month and the Jefferson City Area Board of REALTORS®, Inc. is recognizing this event with a poster contest.

Rules:

- This contest is open to all students in grades 4, 5, and 6 within the jurisdiction of the Jefferson City Area Board of REALTORS®, which includes the counties of Cole, Callaway, Moniteau and Osage.
- The contest will be judged based on each grade level listed above.
- Posters must represent the theme, "Fair Housing: Together We Make A Neighborhood". Posters may be rendered in any art medium, including markers, colored pencils, crayons, etc., but may not exceed 18x24 inches in size. All work must be original—no copies of work done by others.
- Each poster must be submitted with a registration form taped to the back of the poster - neatly typed or printed.
- All entries must be submitted to the Jefferson City Area Board of REALTORS®, 1906 Bubba Lane, Jefferson City, no later than 5:00 p.m. Monday, March 7, 2016.
- All entries may be reproduced, displayed, exhibited, or distributed by the Jefferson City Area Board of REALTORS® as it sees fit.
- First (\$100), second (\$75) and third (\$50) place winners will be selected from each age group. All entrants will receive participation awards.
- The winning entries will be determined by a panel of judges whose decision is final. Criteria for judging are adherence to the theme, originality of concept and design, appeal, technique and craftsmanship. Winners will be announced in March 2016 and will be recognized at a Jefferson City Council meeting in April 2016. All entries will be on display during the month of April at location to be determined.
