

# WELCOME TO WOKKA WOKKA DAY CAMP !

We are very happy that you have enrolled your child in our summer day camp program. Along with all of the activities that we had last year, we will be trying out some new ideas and programs. We would like to hear from you and your child. Please don't hesitate to tell us what you think about our program. We will be emailing you a link for an on-line survey at the conclusion of camp.

Camp Wokka-Wokka hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. After Camp Swim hours are from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. for those who have registered for this part of the program. We provide camp staff to supervise your child from as early as 7:45 a.m. and as late as 3:15 p.m. (5:15 p.m. for those registered for After Camp Swim). We take campers on a field trip every Wednesday from approximately 12:30 to 2:30 p.m.

We require a parent, guardian, or other designated individual to personally check each camper into and out of our day camp with a staff member each day. Please do not drop off your child in the morning or have your child meet you outside the camp or pool. We will not allow your child to leave without someone getting him or her.

Please know that our camps are drug, alcohol and tobacco free zones. City policy prohibits us from holding or dispensing any prescription or over-the-counter medication either internally or externally. Our first aid policy only allows us to insure breathing, control bleeding and swelling. We cannot administer any medicine, either internal or external, under any circumstances. This includes salves, topical ointments, sting-ease, pain reliever, anti-ivy. We are permitted to assist your child in applying sun screen or insect repellent that he or she brings. In the unlikely event that your child is injured, we will contact you immediately with the details and asking for your guidance on further care, if needed.

## **What to wear/bring:**

1. Have your child eat a nutritious and filling breakfast. We plan on lots of hard play!
2. Campers should wear play clothes and tennis shoes and bring a swim suit.
3. Campers should bring their own lunch every day. We suggest that lunches be brought in coolers since we are unable to provide refrigeration. Please include a water bottle for your child, we will have jugs from which to fill them once empty. Please do not bring glass containers of any kind to camp.
4. Campers should bring and wear sunscreen and insect repellent.
5. Lunches, jackets, sunscreen, etc. should be marked with camper's name.
6. To maintain our proper counselor/camper ratio, campers should not bring a friend to camp who is not enrolled in our program.
7. Since we cannot be held responsible for lost valuables, we suggest that campers should not bring any electronics, phones, jewelry, watches, pocket knives or other valuables to camp.

## **After Camp Swim Cancellations:**

The After Camp Swim Program may have to be canceled due to weather conditions on some afternoons. Arrangements can be made to occupy campers time until 5:00 pm, however, we have found that, on those rainy days, it is hard to continue with crafts and quiet games after spending much of the day engaged in similar activities. When after camp swim is canceled, we would like you to pick up your child after regular camp hours. You can pick up your child after 3:00 pm, at Memorial Pavilion. If we know in advance that the After Camp Swim Program will be canceled, we will call you at the earliest possible time to arrange for transportation home from the camp site. If weather conditions require the pool to close once the After Camp Swim Program has begun, we will bring the children back to the Memorial Shelter so we can try to arrange transportation.

If you are able to pick up your child after camp, we will give you a "rain check" swim pass that your child can use to go swimming at one of our pools at a time of your choosing free of charge. If you are unable to arrange

for transportation or supervision for your child, we will be glad to make provisions to keep your child at the camp until 5:00 pm. However, we will not be able to issue a "rain check" swim pass.
