25th ANNUAL ISI CAPITAL CITY CLASSIC

WASHINGTON PARK ICE ARENA JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI March 16-18, 2018

The Jefferson City Department of Parks and Recreation and the Washington Park Ice Arena invite you to attend the 25th Annual Capital City Classic ISI Competition. All entry forms must be signed by the team coach or skating director and postmarked on or before February 16, 2018. All skaters must compete at their highest test level passed as of the registration deadline.

Eligibility

- *The competition is open to all current members of ISI, skaters and teams, and members of US Figure Skating under the joint Statement of Policy.
- *All skaters must be a current Individual member of ISI and have their ISI tests registered. They must also skate at their highest registered test level as of February 16, 2018.
- *USFS skaters who have passed the Pre Preliminary through Senior freestyle tests as of February 16, 2018 should enter as follows. (See the chart below.)

If you are an active USFS member who has competed at or above the Novice level (individual or synchronized) at any USFS National Championship within the last two years we must be notified on the entry forms.

Excerpt from Joint Statement of Policy: U.S. Figure Skating further agrees at the participation of U.S. Figure Skating members in ISI-endorsed recreational skating activities, such as recitals, shows and exhibitions, tests and competitions, endorsed by the ISI is hereby permitted without violating the rules of U.S. Figure Skating, provided that such activities

- 1) are conducted by ISI member rinks, clubs or skating schools in their normal course of business;
- 2) are not conducted by or for the benefit of a third party that exceeds the spirit of this Statement of Cooperation;
- 3) do not include the participation of U.S. Figure Skating member skaters who are or have been active U.S. Championship competitors at or above the Novice level within the past two years unless participation has been permitted as described below; and
- 4) are not intended for television or internet broadcast or re-broadcast. This paragraph represents a grant of special permission from U.S. Figure Skating, in the spirit of cooperation with the ISI, to allow its members to participate in ISI-endorsed recreational skating activities without the need for a separate U.S. Figure Skating sanction.

Events

This competition is open to all levels in the following events:

Tot-Delta, Freestyle 1-10, Open Freestyle, Open Pair, Pair 1-10, Special Skater 1-10, Solo Compulsories, Stroking, Advanced Stroking, Spotlight Events, Rhythmic Skating, Couples Events, Artistic, Interpretive Events, Footwork, Ice Dancing Events, Figures, Hockey Events, Advanced Stroking, Jump and Spin, Ensemble, Family Spotlight, Surprise, Pattern Team, Kaleidoskate Team, Production Team and Synchronized Skating, Team Compulsories, Theater Production and Themed Production Teams.

Groups will be divided by age and gender based on the entries received.

<u>Music</u>

All music should be submitted by email to CC.compmusic@gmail.com no later than March 9th. Please send it as an MP3 with the skater's last name, first name - event name as it's label. It is suggested that you still bring a back up CD along just in case.

<u>Awards</u>

All skaters in each group will receive awards and the top five will receive team points to go toward the overall team awards. The top team awards will be presented at the conclusion of the competition.

Location

Washington Park Ice Arena is located at 711 Kansas Street, Jefferson City, 65109.

*From Highway 54- Exit at Business 50/Missouri Blvd. Turn left at stoplight onto Missouri Blvd. Turn left at stoplight onto Kansas St. Proceed approximately ½ block to 711 Kansas St.

*From Highway 50 -

<u>Heading West</u> – turn left onto Missouri Blvd. at stoplight. Turn left at stoplight onto Kansas St. Proceed approximately ½ block to 711 Kansas St.

<u>Heading East</u> – Exit at Dix Rd. Go right at top of exit ramp. Get into the left turn lane and turn left onto Missouri Blvd. Turn right at stoplight onto Kansas St. Proceed approximately ¹/₂ block to 711 Kansas St.

The Washington Park Ice Arena measures 200' X 85' with bleacher spectator seating and includes 6 dressing rooms.

2 Person Teams:

Silver	half-loop or axel	sit spin or back spin
Gold	double salchow or double toe loop	layback or flying camel
Platinum	double loop or double lutz	flying sit or camel jump camel spin

Solo & Partner Dance - Similar / Mixed / Pro Partner

For this event, all dancers can choose to compete in any dances that they have passed. A separate event entry fee is required for each dance selected. You may also provide your music of choice, otherwise we have standard music options.

Tot 1: Marching While Moving, Proper Way to Fall Down, Proper Way to Get Up
Tot 2: 2-Foot Jump, Single Swizzle, Beginning 2-Foot Glide
Tot 3: Push & Glide Stroking, Forward Swizzles, Dip
Tot 4: Backward Wiggles, Backward Swizzle, 2-Foot or 1-Foot Snowplow Stop

Freestyle 2: Ballet Jump, Waltz Jump-tap toe-1/2 Flip Jump Sequence, 1-Foot Spin
Freestyle 3: Salchow Jump, Change Foot Spin, Backward Pivot
Freestyle 4: Flip Jump, Sit Spin, Loop Jump
Freestyle 5: Camel-sit-upright Spin, Axel Jump, Lutz Jump
Freestyle 6: Double Salchow Jump, Choice Spin (Xfoot/Layback/Sit-Change-Sit), Split Jump
Freestyle 7: 1-Foot Axel-Quarter Flip-Axel Sequence, Flying Camel spin, Double Toe Loop jump
Freestyle 8: Double Loop Jump, Camel-Jump-Camel Spin Combo, Split Lutz Jump
Freestyle 9: Double Lutz Jump, Flying Camel into Jump Sit Spin, Axel-Double Loop Jump Combo
Freestyle 10: Double Axel-Double Toe Loop Combo, Death Drop, Three Arabian Cartwheels or Three Butterfly Jumps

- Special Skater 3: Forward Swizzles, Scooter Push (L or R), Backward Wiggles
- Special Skater 4: T- Position Push, 1-Foot Swizzles (L or R), Forward Crossovers Standing Still
- Special Skater 5: Forward Stroking, Snowplow stop, R/L Forward Crossovers
- Special Skater 6: 2-Foot Turn Fwd to Bkwd, Fwd 1-Foot Glides on a Curve, L 1-Foot Bkwd Swizzles
- Special Skater 7: Backward Stroking, Choice of Stop, L/R Backward crossovers
- Special Skater 8: RFI Mohawk, LFI Mohawk, RBO Edge on a Curve
- Special Skater 9: RFO Three turn, LFO Three Turn, Choice of Stop
- Special Skater 10: Bunny Hop, Lunge, LFI Three Turn

In accordance with the ISI rules, all solo compulsories events will be held in a mini program style with a minimum of connecting steps. <u>Elements do NOT have to be skated in the order listed!</u>

Note: in Tot - Beta levels, there is no penalty for the number of swizzles, wiggles, strokes or crossovers. Only the quality of those maneuvers will be judged.

Freestyle 6—10 will have full ice for compulsory events.

Solo & Partner Dance - Similar / Mixed / Pro Partner
